

How to reach the 12th Biennial JMGA Conference venues.

Day 1 Coles Theatre, Powerhouse Museum.

The Powerhouse Museum is close to Darling Harbour, Chinatown, Central Station (Sydney Terminal), Broadway bus station (Railway Square), and Powerhouse Monorail Station.

Train and bus

Central Station is the closest railway station to the Powerhouse Museum. From Central Station take the eastern exits to Railway Square/George Street. Turn left at Railway Square and walk to Harris Street which is on the right.

Monorail

Turn left from Powerhouse Monorail Station and go to the end of the walkway; the Powerhouse Museum is at your right from the end of the walkway.

Parking

The Entertainment Centre Car park is situated behind the Entertainment Centre and is connected to the Museum via a walkway (mostly covered). There are other parking stations in the area marked on the map.

Day 2 SCA Auditorium, Sydney College of the Arts

Buses to and from the City (Victoria Rd only)

Bus numbers 500, 504, 506, 507, 510, 515, 518, and 520 leave from Circular Quay in the city, turn at the Queen Victoria Building and travel across the Anzac Bridge to Victoria Road and stop on Victoria Road, Rozelle just 1 kilometer from the campus. This is the quickest bus route from the city. The 501, also leaving Circular Quay, travels via Harris Street, past the Powerhouse Museum and the Sydney Fish Markets.

Buses to and from the City (Balmain Rd)

Bus number 440 also leaves from Circular Quay in the city and travels via travels along Parramatta Road past the main University campus, then along Balmain Road ('B' on the map).

Buses to Balmain from Rozelle

Bus numbers 440 and 445 travel along Balmain Road and can be caught from bus stop 'B' on the map. These buses terminate at the Ferry Wharf. Ferries to Circular Quay in the City leave from this wharf.

Light Rail

Lilyfield light rail station is 1.5 kilometres from the campus and provides light rail transport to Sydney Exhibition Centre, Sydney Convention Centre and other facilities in Darling Harbour and on to Central Railway Station. To reach SCA turn right on exiting the station, cross over Lilyfield Road to walk up Grove Street. Turn right at Balmain Road and continue until the traffic lights at the main entrance. This is the quickest way to reach SCA.

Day 3 Wallace Theatre, University of Sydney

By train

Catch a train to Redfern train station, and then take a 10-minute walk to the main campus.

By bus from the City

For the Ross Street entrance to the University on Parramatta Road catch routes 412, 413, 435, 436, 437, 438, 440, 461, 480 from George Street or Railway Square.

By bus - cross routes

Route 370 runs between Coogee and Leichhardt. Alight on City Rd for Sydney University.

Route 352 runs between Bondi Junction and Marrickville. Alight on City Rd for Sydney University.
