CALL FOR ENTRIES**

*Graduate Metal X* is an award exhibition that will be held in conjunction with the biennial Jewellers and Metalsmiths Group of Australia Conference 2006. This exhibition will be the tenth survey of jewellery and metalsmithing graduates from tertiary institutions in Australia and New Zealand.

The exhibition will be held from 27 January – 3 February 2006 in the exit *Galleries* at the conference venue, Sydney College of the Arts, in conjunction with the following exhibitions; *change* by Ruudt Peters and *Luminaries - New Work* by Six Australasian Artists.

Participants in this exhibition can expect their work to be seen by a national and international audience of fellow jewellers and other members of the craft and design community including curators, gallerists, media and collectors.

In addition to exposure to this audience, there will be two awards judged by a distinguished international panel which will be presented at the exhibition opening on 27 January.

The awards confirmed for *Graduate Metal X* are: The Palloys Award with a prize of \$600 worth of casting from Palloys and The Go Goanna Award with a prize of \$400 worth of gemstones and pearls from Go Goanna.
