- ✦ The maker is a current, new or renewing financial member of JMGA-NSW.
- ✦ Applications must be postmarked no later than 13/11/09. Late applications will not be considered.
- ✦ Artwork must have been made during 2008-2010.
- ✦ The artwork must be complete and original.
- ✦ The artwork must not contain fresh fruit, liquids, perishable or dangerous materials.
- ✦ The artwork must be robust enough to travel.
- ✦ The artwork must be suitable for public display.
- ✦ All artwork must be suitably packaged for travel/shipping in as small a package as possible.
- ✦ Selection will take place from submitted images of your artwork or similar to be produced for the exhibition.
- ✦ JMGA-NSW is granted the right to exhibit the selected artworks.
- ✦ Submissions will only be eligible for selection and judging if they meet these conditions.
- ✦ Correspondence will not be entered into if your artwork is not accepted for any reason.

Open to any current member who is a full time student to Honours level or who has been practising for no more than three years.

There will be at least one award in each category. The judges may choose to offer more than one award in each category.

## SELECTION AND JUDGING

Artwork will be selected by a panel of JMGA-NSW Committee members and established practitioners respected in their field. Judges will be appointed by the committee. A list of judges will be available on [www.jmgansw.org.au](http://www.jmgansw.org.au) in the near future.

## ENTRY FEE

\$28 or \$22 for fulltime students or pensioners.

## KEY DATES & REQUIREMENTS

Entries must be postmarked no later than 13th November 2009. and must include:

- ✓ A completed entry form.
- ✓ A CD containing a maximum of three images of actual artworks, high quality drawings or renderings. It is in your interest to ensure your images are of a high standard and print quality of 300 dpi, with a minimum file size of 10 MB. Please state if images are of intended artworks or examples only.
- ✓ Cheque, money order or paypal (via [www.jmgansw.org.au](http://www.jmgansw.org.au)) made in favour of JMGA-NSW Inc for the entry fee of \$28 or \$22.
- ✓ A JMGA-NSW membership application with applicable fees if required.

Selection will take place during the week beginning 16th November, and makers of accepted artwork will be notified by email between 23/11/09 and 27/11/09 at the latest. Please make sure your email address is active and is clearly written on the entry form.

Selected artwork to arrive no later than 26/2/10. You are encouraged to post artwork via Express Post or Registered Post.

Announcement of awards will be made at the opening of the Sydney exhibition on 2 March 2010.

## PERIOD OF LOAN & RETURN OF ARTWORKS

Period of the loan will be from the date of delivery until completion of Perth exhibition. Artwork is to be collected from a venue to be advised or returned by COD post.

## SALE OF ARTWORKS

Artwork must be for sale and will be made available to the purchaser at the close of the tour. A 50% commission will apply. If you are selected for exhibition you will be asked to provide pricing and to sign a loan agreement with JMGA-NSW.

## STORAGE AND INSURANCE

The artwork will not be insured by JMGA-NSW during storage or in transit to and from Perth. The artwork will be displayed at the Central Tafe Art Gallery, but it will not be covered by insurance during this time. The gallery will be attended during opening hours.

The artwork will be insured whilst on exhibition at Studio 20/17 but will not be exhibited in locked cabinets.

All care will be taken, however, JMGA-NSW will not be liable for damage to or loss of artwork. It is advised that you insure your artwork whilst in transit and on display in Perth.
